# **INTRODUCTION**

Following is the brief report on activities conducted by Degree College during this academic year 2020-21:

# **ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED:**

### 1. Celebration of International Yoga Day:

On 21<sup>st</sup> June 2020, NSS Unit of M V Mandali's Colleges of Commerce and Science in association with MVM Junior college have organized training session on the occasion of International Yoga Day. College invited students, teaching & non-teaching staff, friends, etc. The seminar was taken by Dr. Gopal Kalkoti, Principal MVM College. This is clearly visible from the continuous increase in learners's enrollment over the years. Over the years there is tremendous increase in leaner's enrollment.
