IQAC & CDC Meetings:

Guest Lectures

Guest Lectures were organised for TY students in month of April 2022, where subject experts were invited to guide students in their exam preparation.

Faculty Development:

During this academic year our faculty members were invited to various colleges as Resource Persons to conduct sessions and workshops. On 24th June 2021 Principal Dr Gopal Kalkoti was invited as Resource Person for Faculty Development Programme at GHG Khalsa College of Education. On 11th January 2022, Dr. Kalkoti, Dr. Seema Rawat, Ms. Anita Chaudhary were invited as Resource Persons for "Preparation for Project Work" at Valia College.

Faculty Achievement:

- Dr Seema Rawat and Ms Venu Swadia successfully completed 21 days' Orientation Programme between 19th July to 08th August 2021 organised UGC HRDC.
- Ms. Shweta Pawar successfully completed her NET- UGC in Computer Science. This achievement of Ms. Shweta Pawar is remarkable as NET- UGC is highly competitive exam, where

passing percentage is very low, especially in Computer Science and Applications discipline. Only two faculties cleared this National Level Competitive Test in entire Mumbai University during AY 2021-22. One of them is our faculty from MVM College- Ms. Shweta Pawar

- Ms. Seema Rawat successfully completed her Ph.D. in Commerce in August 2021.

Remedial Programme

Two Weeks remedial programme was conducted for academically weak students, where faculty members guided them before exams and helped them in their exam preparation. This programme helped our students to score good marks and clear their exams successfully.

Anusansaadhan- Research week

Anusansaadhan is one of the best practices implemented by the IQAC. It is a research programme for beginners organised by Research Round Table every year. It is a 3 to 4 days programme where students and faculty members are provided guidance on various aspects of writing quality research papers in national and international journals. This year also this programme is conducted between 24th to 26th February 2022.

Bridge the Gap Course

Bridge the Gap programme is another best practice implemented by the IQAC where first year students from non-commerce background are provided with lecture series focusing on various basic concepts of accountancy, mathematics, economics, communications etc. Clarity of concepts help them to cope up with the subjects easily, thereby help them to understand the subjects content in better way. This year also this programme was conducted between 25th October 2021 to 3rd November 2021.

Technology Training Programme on ERP- Academix

IQAC has organised Technology Training Programme on “ERP- Academix” for faculty and admin Staff on 14th August 2021 in order to implement smooth functioning of ERP system in campus.

National Conference
