- The college organised its first TechnoFest ExpoGen, with participation from 34 colleges and 120 participants.

- The college organised a one-day online National Conference and for the first time the college will be publishing the researcher papers in its own ISBN conference proceedings Anvesha.
- Entrepreneurial Spark was conducted by Entrepreneur cell in association with Rotaract Club where the students participated by putting up their stall and learned budgeting, marketing, pricings, accounting, etc
- The college received a Memento of Appreciation for NSS from the University of Mumbai for volunteering blood donation camp.
- Our college name appeared in BCom, BAF, BFM and M.Com. Syllabus which reached all the University of Mumbai affiliated colleges for our I/c Principal, Dr. Navsin Mistry was a part of syllabus revision committee for NEP.

### **MAJOR INITIATIVE TAKEN by IQAC (Internal Quality Assurance Cell):**

#### **IQAC & CDC Meetings:**

Four IQAC and four CDC meetings were conducted at regular intervals during AY 2023-24 to take quality initiatives for the overall growth and development of the institution.

#### **Guest Lectures**

Guest Lectures were organised for TY students and M.Com. students for both the semesters, where subject experts were invited to guide students in their exam preparation.

### **Remedial Program**

A one-week remedial program was conducted for academically weak students, where faculty members guided them before exams and helped them in their exam preparation. This program helped our students score good marks and clear their exams successfully. This year, the program was conducted from 9th to 18th September 2023.

### **Bridge the Gap Course**

The Bridge the Gap program is another best practice implemented by the IQAC, where first-year students, especially those from non-commerce backgrounds, are provided with lecture series focusing on various basic concepts of accountancy, mathematics, economics, etc. Clarity of concepts helps them to cope with the subjects easily, thereby helping them to understand the subject's content better. This year, the program was conducted from 14th to 18th September 2023.

### **FDP on "How to write the Research Paper"**

In collaboration with the Research Cell, IQAC organized a five-day FDP on “How to Write a Research Paper” from 25th to 30th September 2023. Faculty members with PhDs and those pursuing PhDs guided other faculty members on research and how to write good quality research papers.

### **Session on IPR**

In collaboration with the Research Cell, IQAC organized a session on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) on 30th April 2024. Dr. Hema Mehta served as the resource person for the session. The session aimed to enhance the understanding of IPR among faculty and students, covering essential topics such as patents, copyrights, and trademarks. Dr. Hema Mehta provided valuable insights into the importance of protecting intellectual property in academic research and innovation.

### **One Day Online National Conference Anvesha'24**

IQAC has organized a one-day online national conference, Anvesha'24, on the theme “Exploring New Frontiers: Women Redefining Leadership” on 31st May 2024 via the online platform Google Meet. The conference saw a total of 57 participants from 37 colleges across Maharashtra and beyond.
